



## 2019 UMTA Concerto Competition

### Concerto Competition Instructions:

1. Registration for Concerto competitions is done online through the UMTA website.
2. All payments will be made through this registration process via Paypal.
3. Registration opens January 2nd, 2019 and closes on January 16th, 2019 at midnight. No exceptions.
4. Teachers and/or students/parents may register. However, all information must be entered correctly before the application will be accepted. The completed application and payment must be received and accepted by the deadline.
5. **Repertoire performed MUST be a concerto. Classical concerti only. Composers from the UMTA National composer list can be a reference.**
6. Performance times need to be accurate in order to facilitate the competition scheduling. Teachers: Do NOT make any cuts to the concerto solo parts. The full concerto movement must be learned, including the cadenza. (The accompanist part may have cuts to accommodate time limits.) Students with cuts in their solo part will be disqualified.
7. **Time Limits:**
  - o Elementary - 8 minutes
  - o Jr. High - 10 minutes
  - o Sr. High - 13 minutes
  - o Collegiate - 15 minutes
8. There is no "Evaluation Only" option, only the competition.
9. Fees for registration are: \$35 for students with a UMTA member Teacher. \$100 for students with a non-UMTA member Teacher. Teacher membership will be confirmed before the registration application is approved.
10. A screen, for the accompanist, will be in place for the Piano Concerto competition, so teachers may accompany their student, if desired.
11. If you have additional questions, please contact the Piano Concerto Chair, or the Instrumental Concerto Chair.

### Financial Awards - Concerto Competitions

Elementary (8-11 yrs) = \$25 First Place

Jr. High (12-14 yrs) = \$25 First Place

Sr. High (15-18) = \$50 First Place

Collegiate (19+ /Full-time college student) \$100 First Place
